

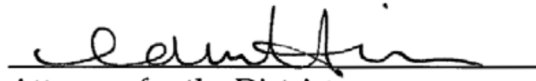
NOTICE OF MEETING

FORT BEND COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 23

The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 23 will hold a special meeting on **Tuesday, September 15, 2026, at 6:30 p.m.**, at the M.R. Massey Administration Building, 1570 W. Sycamore Road, Fresno, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Conduct hearing on the termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and taxpayers and authorize termination of service.
2. Review EVO Report and take appropriate action, if necessary.
3. District engineering matters, including approve proposals for improvements to District facilities.
4. District security matters, including receive report from Fort Bend County Sheriff's Office.
5. District website and communication matters, including approve related proposals and correspondence.
6. Parks and recreational facilities matters, including:
 - a. update on pending repairs and authorize additional repairs and improvements as appropriate;
 - b. design of park facilities, plan approval, advertisement for bids, contract award, and pay estimates for park construction projects, including:
 - i. 10-acre park tract;
 - ii. hardscape to serve District trails, including update on Texas Parks and Wildlife Recreational Grant; and
 - iii. update on new Texas Parks and Wildlife grant application.
7. Reports from Directors and District consultants on District operations.
